Subject :- Approval as a "Pipe Fabricator" Class-1 under Indian Boiler Regulations 1950

Gentleman,

With reference to your letter no.NIL, dated 23-01-2023, and subsequent visit of the competent person of this Directorate to your workshop on 24-01-2023, for purpose of verification your competency as "Pipe Fabricator" I have inform you that same is found satisfactory. You are now provisionally permitted to undertake the "Pipe Fabrication Work" Class-1 coming under the purview of Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950 & Maharashtra Boiler Rules, 1962 and its latest amendment and under the supervision of this Directorate for a period up to 31.12.2024, subject to the following conditions:

- 1) In each and every case you should approach this Directorate along with authorization letter from the owner of boiler as defined under section 2(d) and obtain written permission prior to commencement of work.
- 2) The layout drawings of pipelines shall be submitted in this office and approval should be obtained before offering the material for inspection.
- 3) All material like pipes, flanges, fittings etc. must be offered for inspection (and test whenever required), before fabrication or erection and inspection of weld preparation before welding.
- 4) Only such welders who possess valid certificates in Form XIII as prescribed in Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950 and issued by a Competent Authority listed in Appendix I of Indian Boiler Regulation, 1950, should be engaged for the material, type and class of welding for which they are qualified.
- 5) Requisite percentage of welded joints should be offered for non-destructive tests and reports shall be submitted for scrutiny acceptance.
- 6) Pre heat and post weld heat treatment of welded joints should be carried out wherever necessary as per Indian Boiler Regulations, 1950 and reports along with charts shall be submitted for scrutiny and acceptance.
- 7) On completion of pipe fabrication work, pipe line must be offered for hydraulic test.

- 09) As per rule 152(3) of Maharashtra Boiler Rules 1962, any change in Production/Quality Control related staff should be immediately informed to this office
- 10) As per rule 155 of Maharashtra Boiler Rules 1962, approval will be withdrawn if –
 - i) It is revealed that this approval is obtained by furnishing incorrect or false information.
 - ii) No fabrication activity is carried out for a continuous period of six months.
- 11) Application for renewal of this approval should be submitted to this office at least one month before its expiry date.
- 12) All instructions and directives given by this Directorate, should be followed.
